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Inova Loudoun Hospital, four other hospitals deemed best value

Five local hospitals scored high marks on a new national list of health care providers, and this region's market ranked 41st out of the nation's 98 markets.

Data Advantage LLC studied and ranked 1,500 general acute-care hospitals in the 100 largest U.S. cities, scored by weighing the hospital's clinical quality, its costs and prices, the experience of patients and its public reputation. This market scored 55.9 overall out of 100 points.

The following D.C.-area hospitals were named "Best in Value" out of the 18 studied in the market:

Virginia Hospital Center-Arlington, with a score of 72.3, made the top 100 of best value hospitals, along with Warren Memorial Hospital with a score of 70.7.

The highest national score for a best value hospital was 84.1 for [Fairview Northland Medical Center](#) in Princeton, Minn.

The top two markets were in New York: Buffalo-Niagara Falls (70.3) and Rochester (69.3). Springfield, Mass. (67.7) came in third.

Maryland hospitals weren't ranked, since they do not have to report hospital data to [Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services](#).

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
